Literacy:

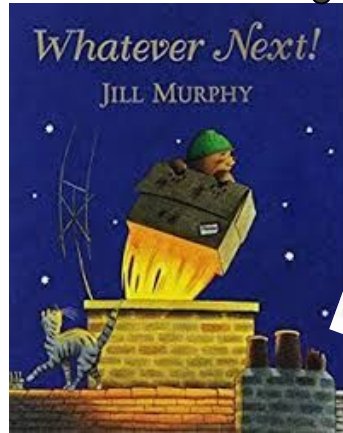
Retelling the story of 'Whatever Next'.
