### Quality of Education

1:1 Continue to embed the curriculum across the school by ensuring it is:

- Inclusive, accessible and is implemented to meet the needs of all learners, particularly those with SEND and those who need to catch-up
- Focussing on teaching being designed to help pupils know and remember more, through the use of retrieval practice
- Continue to embed progressive and selective approach to teaching of vocabulary across the school in all curriculum areas

1:2 To refine our approach to home learning ensuring it is timely, accessible and meets the needs of all children

1:3 To continue to refine our writing curriculum across the school by ensuring the teaching of the 'practising writing' stage is of the best quality and supports rapid progress across all groups

1:4 To increase the % of GD pupils across the school in writing

### Behaviour and Attitudes

2:1 To reduce the number of fixed term suspensions through bespoke intervention and nurture planning and through collaboration with the behaviour hub

2:2 To improve levels of attendance and punctuality

### Personal Development

3:1 Develop the role of our Sports leaders, smart school council and Wellbeing Ambassadors to promote good physical and mental health

3:2 To support children in keeping safe in all areas of life especially online and ensure the pastoral provision meets individual needs across the school
